

Getting Tested in Bassetlaw

Coronavirus (COVID-19) infection rates in Bassetlaw are rising sharply. Now most legal restrictions have been lifted it is vitally important that residents self-isolate and get a PCR test if they, or anyone they live with, develop symptoms of COVID-19. The symptoms are:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- you've lost your sense of smell or taste, or they've changed.

PCR testing for people in Bassetlaw who have COVID-19 symptoms is available at:

- Central Avenue, Worksop
- A mobile PCR testing unit is available at Churchgate in Retford on Monday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Test kits can also be ordered online to be delivered to your home. You can book a full PCR test at your nearest local testing centre on www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or by calling 119.

One in three people with COVID-19 don't have symptoms but can still pass it on. That is why we all need to keep getting tested, even if you have been vaccinated. By getting a weekly or twice weekly test you can play your part in breaking the chain of transmission and help to stop the spread of COVID-19 in Bassetlaw.

Rapid (LFT) testing for people without symptoms is available at:

- Retford Town Hall, 17 The Square, Retford, Tuesday to Friday
- Outside the Savoy Cinema, The Old Market Square, Worksop, Monday to Saturday

Test kits can also be ordered online to be delivered to your home, from the Pharmacy Collect service and Community Collect service via: <https://maps.test-and-trace.nhs.uk/>

If you get a positive result, it is likely that you were infectious at the time the test was taken. You must immediately book a full PCR test at your nearest local testing centre on www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or by calling 119. In this instance please begin self-isolation and follow all guidance.
