Thanks to English Heritage.....

East Drayton PCC is pleased to announce that we have been awarded the Stage 2 grant from English Heritage to repair the roof and improve the drainage/ventilation in St Peters Church.

The grant is for £137,000 and the Church have to raise the remaining £35,000, which is for the VAT on the work and £6,500 of grant ineligible repairs. The committee have applied to various grant awarding bodies for the remainder of funding required, although the work will not be able to start until September as there is a bat colony and we have to wait their departure in the Autumn.

We are very grateful for all your support with fundraising activities. This work will ensure that St Peters Church is available to the community in the future.
