As you know, the red phone box on Top Street has dual purpose.

Firstly, and most importantly, the box houses the village defibrillator; a vital piece of equipment which must always be accessible in case of emergency.

Secondly, it serves as a well-used book exchange, providing those who use it with an ever-changing selection of free books.

If using the book exchange, **please** ensure the **defibrillator** is **NOT obstructed** in any way. Vital seconds can be lost if people have to negotiate obstacles! Place your book donations on the shelves and PLEASE DO NOT leave bags or boxes of books on the floor. If the shelves are full, leave donations in the porch at the village hall on Mondays from 10-11, or from 10-1.30 on Meet n Eat days and during Book Group (see dates below). Soon, the village hall committee will be providing a lidded storage box at the entrance to the Village Hall, in order that books can be left there at any time.
