Do you know about MILTON MAUSOLEUM – the historic gem on your doorstep? (Image above) Situated on The Avenue between Milton and West Markham this iconic building was built by the 4th Duke of Newcastle to honour his young wife who died in childbirth in 1822. The family's home was Clumber House. The Mausoleum is open for guided tours on **Sunday afternoons between 2 and 4pm, until the 28th September.** Knowledgeable and enthusiastic guides will share the story of the Newcastle family and you can see the stunning memorial to Georgiana. For the history buffs amongst you – the Mausoleum (and the Saxon church in West Markham) are open from 10am – 4pm on Saturday and Sunday 13th and 14th September for the national Heritage Weekend.
